

The school history and present in brief.

Secondary school of building and transportation engineering Liberec is an allowance organization established by the District of Liberec. Originally it was founded as Secondary apprentice building training centre in the year 1957, and then it was a part of the firm called "Pozemní stavby Liberec", and trained mainly apprentices of building professions. After the year 1990 it integrated with Centre of electrotechnic handy training, Integrated secondary school of transportation and building engineering and Secondary school of technical engineering. The mentioned organizational changes caused a considerable expansion of the fields of study that the school offers its students. The number of students increased subsequently too. There are 1260 students at the school today. At the present time the school teaches the following fields of study focused on machinery, building and transportation engineering:

The secondary school also runs the Children Traffic Training Field in Liberec, at Lužická street 147/38 (telephone number: 488880499) and ensures the cooperation of traffic education at primary schools for the whole District of Liberec. The school started to participate in international projects in the mid 90's of the last century. The longest project was the PHARE programme – the reformation of training education. Our school was one of ninety pilot training schools in the Czech Republic. That programme had a significant contribution for the school in pedagogical and material field. Consequently the employees of the school handed in a lot of successful applications to another international and national programmes. There are concerned especially the upgrade social projects of the European Union Leonardo da Vinci, Operational programme ESF development of human sources, the cooperation with the Czech – German fund of the future and other projects. The pedagogical staff have made use of the gained experience and knowledge all the time and have used it for example for creation of the school educational programmes and programmes for special courses which are established by the secondary school in the scope of joining the project of the Centre of Education in the District of Liberec. All these facts contribute to the high level of education and spreading the activity of the school. A good example is the welding school which passed the audit of the European welding federation. Now it offers the students, and first of all the firm employees in Liberec region obtaining a welding certificate according to the European standards for welding metals and plastics in a large number of methods. A part of the school is also a dormitory with the capacity of 280 beds and the school kitchen.

Despite the above described successes the management of the school follows changes and development of the fields of study all the time. That is why the school also maintains good relations with many firms in Liberec region and with school in Germany, Sweden, Poland and Slovakia.
